### ***Stealing Secrets* by H. Donald Winkler**



### ***Beneath a Scarlet Sky* by Mark T. Sullivan**


A young Italian man braves war's horrors, working as an Allied spy within the German High Command. **Book Buzz!**


### ***The Mystery of Mrs. Christie* by Marie Benedict**
