Dichotomous Key for Common Utah Amphibians

1a.	Adult with long tail.	It is a Tiger Salamander
1b.	Adult without tail.	Frogs and Toads Go to 2
2a.	Skin rough and warty.	It is a Toad
2b.	Skin moist and smooth.	It is a Frog Go to 3
За.	Red, spotty warts on tan or gray body.	It is a Red Spotted Toad
3b.	No red spotty warts, but still warts.	Go to 4a
4a.	Spadefoot (a wedge-shaped shovel on back toes), light stripes on side.	It is a Great Basin Spadefoot Toad
4b.	No spadefoot, irregular spots.	It is a Woodhouse's Toad
5a.	Large, over 5 inches long.	It is an American Bullfrog
5b.	Not large, less than 5 inches long.	Go to 6
6a.	Three stripes on back with a dark one through eye.	It is a Boreal Chorus Frog
6b.	Has both spots and/or stripes.	Go to 7
7a.	Has large, irregular, dark spots, greenish color.	It is a Northern Leopard Frog
7b.	Can have spots, has big toepads.	It is a Canyon Tree Frog
