


## **UTAH'S MUNICIPALITIES HAVE LOTS OF CLASS!**

Utah's municipalities (cities and towns) are divided into cities of the 1st class, 2nd class, 3rd class, 4th class, or 5th class. This does not mean that a 1st class city is better than a 4th class city. The "class" of a city or town is determined by the size of its population (the number of people living there).

City or Town Population	Class
100,000+	Cities of the 1st class
65,000 – 100,000	Cities of the 2nd class
30,000 - 65,000	Cities of the 3rd class
10,000 - 30,000	Cities of the 4th class
1,000 - 10,000	Cities of the 5th class
Fewer than 1,000	Towns
