MUNICIPALITY

is a word used to describe cities and towns that have their own government.

Utah cities or municipalities have three branches of government modeled after the state and national government.

Executive Branch

SOMETIMES VETOES
LEGISLATIVE LAWS.*

Legislative Branch

*WITHIN THIS BRANCH,
LEGISLATORS MAKE LAWS.
LEGISLATORS ARE PEOPLE
WHO REPRESENT
CITIZENS OF VARIOUS
POINTS OF VIEW.*

Judicial Branch

*WITHIN THIS BRANCH,
COURTS AND JUDGES
MAKE SURE THAT LAWS
ARE OBEYED.*
