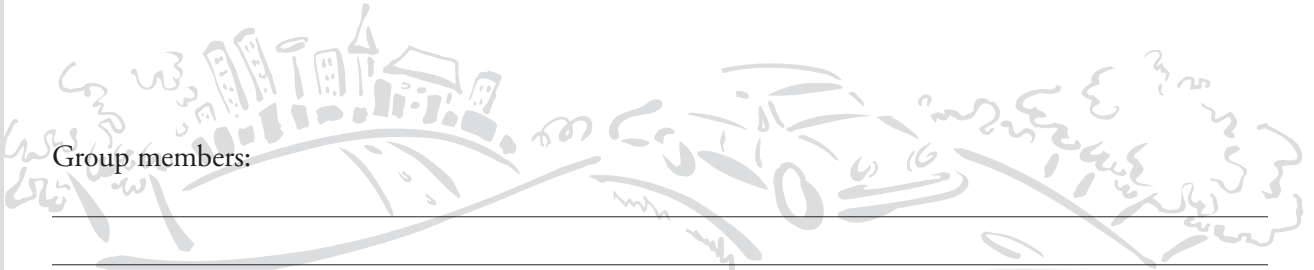

CITY REPORT

List your assigned communities:

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Locate each assigned community on the “Municipalities and Population as of 2004” information sheets. Write a short report about each community.

Answer the following questions:

1. How did the community receive its name?
2. What is the population of the community?
3. Where is the community located? (Use the map to identify the location.)
4. How far is it from your own city or town to the assigned community? (Use the map to determine mileage and explain various routes that could be used to travel to the community.)
5. Explain why it might be fun to visit the community.

Use your creativity to plan a presentation about each assigned community. You may work together or in small groups to present your findings.

Use a Utah map and highlight (highlighter or crayon) each of the cities or towns assigned to your group.

Use the municipality population chart on “Utah’s Municipalities Have Lots of Class” worksheet to identify whether your community is a city or town.

Prepare a short presentation about the municipalities studied by your group. Explain what you have learned about each community. Describe where they are located on the Utah map, what is the 2004 estimated population, and what are some interesting facts about each community? If your team has access to a computer, you may wish to see if the communities have home pages for further information.
