Assignment: Play “WHAT’S LEFT?” with a member of your family. Write two of your equations on the bottom of this paper and return to school by _____.

WHAT'S LEFT?

Materials: 5-10 objects (coins, spoons, blocks, paper clips, Froot Loops, etc.) and two small bowls

How to play the game: Place a number of manipulatives in one bowl. The first person takes out some of the objects and places them on the table and covers them with the second container while the second person turns around. The first person says to the other person, "I had 5 blocks and I took out 3. What's left? The second person gives the answer. The first person takes the cover off the objects and they check the answer. Each person takes turns covering and turning around.
