(to: "When Johnny Comes Marching Home Again". Lyrics by Linda Bolin)

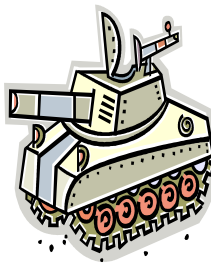
When several operations must be done, be done.
