WWW

- The World Wide Web

Browser

- Software program that allows a person to view WWW documents. Examples of browsers are Netscape, Microsoft Internet Explorer, Mosaic, Mac web, and Net cruiser.

Search Engine

- A web site that will help you search the Internet for key words, subjects, etc.

URL

- UNIFORM RESOURCE LOCATOR- The unique address of any web page. It tells your computer where the information is stored so it can be viewed.

Domain

- A way to indicate what type of site you may be viewing. In the U.S. some common domains are .com-commercial, .org- non-profit and research organizations, .gov- government agency, .edu-education. More are constantly being added so theses should only be used as guidelines to help you know what type of site you are on.

- The Language used to create Web Pages
