

## Vocabulary Cards

<b>Measure</b>	To find the length, capacity, or weight of an item using units.
<b>Unit</b>	A specific amount of something related to length, capacity, or weight
<b>Metric System</b>	The system of measurement used outside of the U.S., using 10 as its base.
<b>Meter (m)</b>	A length of measurement used in the Metric System, containing 100cm.
<b>Centimeter (cm)</b>	A length of measurement used in the Metric System. (10cm = Lg.paper clip)

<b>Customary System</b>	The system of measurement used in the U.S., using units such as: inches, feet, yards, cups, quarts, ounces and pounds.
<b>Perimeter</b>	The length around a shape measured in customary or metric units.
<b>Elapsed Time</b>	The measurement of time that has passed from one point to another.
