1.12.2 Language of the Stock Market : Students develop an understanding about stock market fundamentals. They learn what stocks are, associated risks, types of stock, and how stocks are classified. Students also learn how to use the fundamental measures to research a stock, read a stock quote, recognize stock market indicators, and understand the process brokers use to buy and sell stocks on the organized exchange.
