## Understanding Your Paycheck Teacher Information

\*Note to teacher: The facilitation of this lesson includes clips from the movie "The Pursuit of Happyness." In addition, a blank W-4,1040EZ and State Tax Form for each participant to complete is suggested. These forms can be downloaded from <u>www.irs.gov/formspubs</u>.

- 1. Play the start of chapter 20 from the movie "The Pursuit of Happyness" for approximately four minutes.
  - a. This scene begins with the main character Chris Gardner, played by Will Smith, stating "This part of my life is called paying taxes."
  - b. Discuss with participants the following:
    - i. Why did the government seize the money from Chris's account?
    - ii. Does the government have the right to do this with only the notification of a letter?
    - iii. What suggestions do you have for Chris to correct the situation?
- 2. Pass out *Understanding Your Paycheck* note taking guide 1.13.1.L1.
- 3. Instruct students to complete the note taking guide by filling in information learned during the PowerPoint presentation.
- 4. Present Understanding Your Paycheck PowerPoint 1.13.1.G1
  - a. Slide 1: Introduction
  - b. Slide 2: Where Does My Money To?
  - c. Slides 3-8: Paying Employees
  - d. Slides 9: Describe Taxes
  - e. Slide 10-11: Discuss the Form W-4 and how they affect Federal Taxes W-4
  - f. Slide 12: Hand out blank Form W-4s
  - g. Slide 13: Discuss the Form 1-9
  - h. Slides 14-28 Review each part of a paycheck stub
- 5. Pass out Understanding Your Paycheck Worksheet information sheet 1.13.1.F1.
- 6. Have student's correct their note taking guides using the *Understanding Your Paycheck* information sheet 1.13.1.F1.
- 7. Use a transparency of *Paycheck Stub 1* 1.13.1.A2 and fill out the parts as a class. For additional practice pass out *Paycheck Stub 2* 1.13.1.A3.
- 8. Go to the Internal Revenue Service (<u>www.irs.gov)>Individual>Students>Understand</u> Taxes Lesson Plans. This is an internet-based interactive program about taxation. Lesson plans are

available and tax filing simulations that can help complete **#3 Performance Objective A**-Demonstrate how to complete personal state and federal tax forms.
