BINGO REVIEW

- 1. Play Bingo as a review of this unit.
- 2. The game is played just like regular Bingo, except words are used instead of numbers.
- 3. Let each student prepare his/her own Review Bingo card by choosing 25 words from the vocabulary list transparency. Have them write one term in each square of the card. They can place the terms in any order. Each card will be different from everyone else's card.
- 4. The teacher should then read a definition from the vocabulary sheets. (The teacher may wish to copy the vocabulary words, then cut them into strips and place them in a hat and let the students draw out a definition, then read it to the class.) If the student has the term that matches the definition, she/he can cross it off. The first one who has marked five squares in a row (horizontally, vertically, or diagonally) wins. The winner must read off the answers and give a definition for each word in order to win the game. You will need a bingo card for each student.
