VOCABULARY FEMALE REPRODUCTION TEACHER KEY (Primary)

- 1. Cervix (SER-vix): opening from the uterus to the vagina.
- 2. Clitoris (KLIT-or-us): a small, pea-shaped bump at the front of the labia that contains erectile tissue (counterpart to male penis).
- **3. Endometrium:** lining of uterus.
- **4. Estrogen:** the hormone responsible for secondary sex characteristics and for the sex drive in females. The egg producing hormone.
- 5. Fertilization (conception): a sperm entering an ovum.
- 6. Menstruation: release of dead endometrial tissue and blood.
- Menstrual cycle (MEN-stroo-al): the process of passing the blood and tissue lining of the uterus from the body.
- 8. Ova (OH-vah)--plural, Ovum (OH-vum)-singular: the female reproductive cell.
- 9. Ovaries: organs holding a woman's eggs.
- **10.** Fallopian tubes: two tubular structures leading from the ovaries to the uterus.
- **11. Ovulation (OV-u-lay-shun):** time when the egg is released from the ovary.
- **12. Progesterone:** builds up the lining of the uterus to prepare it for the fertilized ovum.; the egg-setting hormone.
- **13. Utethra:** below clitoris, the opening to bladder.
- 14. Uterus (You-ter-us) (womb): place where the baby grows in a woman's abdomen.
- **15.** Vagina (vah-JINE-ah): passageway between the uterus and the outside of a woman's body.
