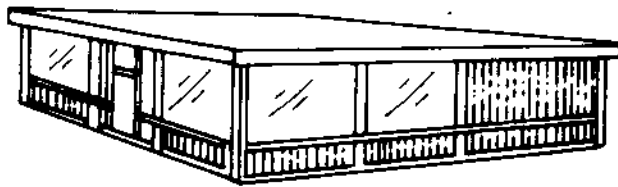

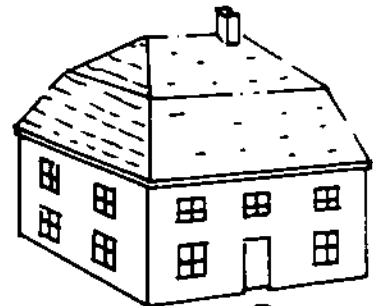

Roof Styles

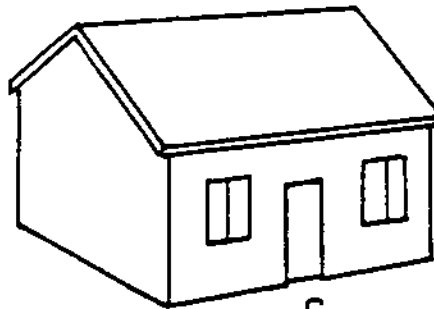

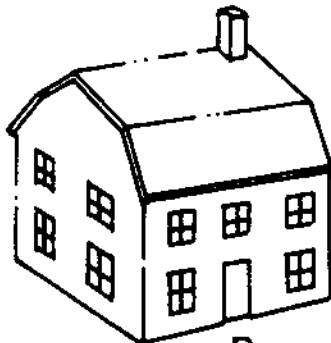

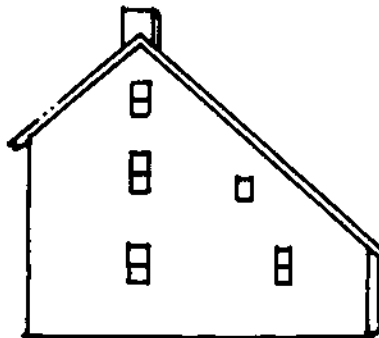

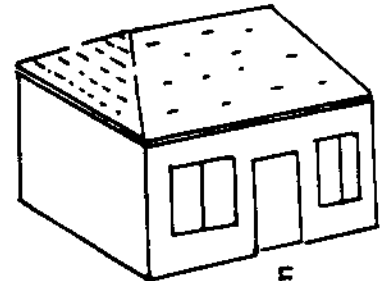
