

HOME ACTIVITY Drying Laundry





Today I learned that:

Temperature and surface area affect evaporation rates. In class we measured and compared how different-sized water puddles evaporate.

Fun Focus:

This home activity will demonstrate some of the factors that influence evaporation.



Materials:

4 Paper towels Water Teaspoon Fan



Procedure:



Place one teaspoon of water on each of the 4 paper towels.



Put one towel in a cold place and one towel in a warm place. Observe both to see which dries first. Record the drying times.



Put another towel in a breezy place (fan) and one where there is not a breeze. Record the drying times.
