


- * eats Pocket Mouse and Pocket Gopher

 - * eaten by Cougar and Badger

- * eats Muledeer, Badger, and Pocket Mouse
- * hunted by Humans



Cougars


- * relies upon Wasatch Penstemon and Scarlet Gilia for survival
- * eaten by Spider

Flies

- * relies upon sun, soil, and water for survival
- * eaten by Muledeer and Pocket Mouse

Bitterbrush

- * uses Gambel's Oak for shelter and food
- * eats Caterpillars or Gall Wasp

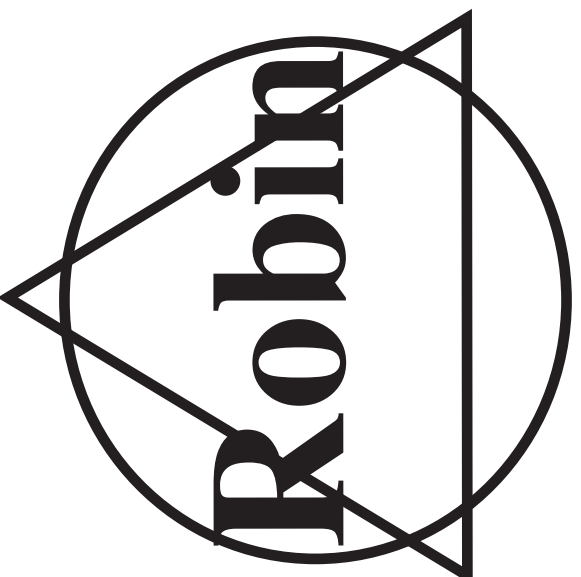

Scrub Jay

- * relies upon Wasatch Penstemon for survival
- * eaten by Spider

Bumblebee

- * uses Chokecherry for food and shelter
- * eats Caterpillars or Gall Wasp



- * relies upon sun, soil, and water for survival
- * cherries eaten by Robins, and Humans
- * used for shelter by the Caterpillars or Gall Wasp, and the Spotted Towhee

Chokecherry


Caterpillars or Gall Wasp

- * relies upon Gambel's Oak and Chokecherry for survival
 - * eaten by Robin and Scrub Jay
-

- * relies upon Bluebunch Wheatgrass, Bitterbrush, Gambel's Oak, and Bigtooth Maple for survival
- * eaten by Cougar and Humans

Muledeer

- * uses Chokecherry and Gambel's Oak
- * hunts Muledeer and Cougar



Swans

- * relies upon Scarlet Gilia for survival
- * eaten by Spotted Towhee and Spider

Beetles

Gambel's Oak

(Scrub Oak)

- * relies upon sun, soil, and water for survival
- * seeds eaten by Scrub Jays
- * leaves are eaten as forage by Muledeer
- * used as shelter by Caterpillars or Gall Wasp

- * eats Bumblebee, Flies, and Beetles
- * eaten by Spotted Towhee

Spiders

- * relies upon sun, soil, and water for survival
 - * Bumblebees use the flowers for food while pollinating the plant
 - * used for shelter by the Pocket Gopher, Pocket Mouse and Flies


Wasatch Penstemon

- * relies upon Bluebunch Wheatgrass and Wasatch Penstemon for survival
 - * eaten by Badger
-

Pocket Gopher

- * uses Chokecherry for shelter
- * eats Beetles and Spider

Spotted Towhee



- * relies upon sun, soil, and water for survival
- * flowers provide nectar for Hummingbirds, and hummingbirds pollinate the plants
- * used as shelter by Flies and Beetles

Scarlet Gilia

Bigtooth Maple

- * relies upon sun, soil, and water for survival
- * eaten by Muledeer

- * relies upon Scarlet Gilia for survival
- * is the only pollinator of Scarlet Gilia

PrigŕimumH

- * relies upon sun, soil, and water for survival
- * eaten by Muledeer, Pocket Mouse, and Pocket Gopher
