UNIT: SEWING TOPIC: Hems
TIMELINE: 1 day

## **OBJECTIVES:**

- 1. Students will observe a demonstration on hemming.
- 2. Students will select the appropriate type of hem for their projects.
- 3. Students will hem their individual projects.

## MOTIVATOR/INTRODUCTION:

Show the students various articles of clothing with different hems: frayed hem on denim short or skirts, top-stitched hem, machine blind hem, hand hems. Let them observe and see which look they like best. Explain that different hems are required for different fabrics.

## INFORMATION:

Review the information found in the 4-H manual "Clothing Yourself", section 9--Hems. Have examples, a teaching board, or demonstrate as you explain the various types of hems you wish the class to become familiar with.
