COLOR DISTRIBUTION CHART

Divide a room into seven areas of color, noting the percentage of the room each color will cover. Remember the law of color distribution: bright colors weigh heavily in their power to attract attention and can balance much larger areas of grayed color.

- Select a color to be used in the largest areas. (It is best to keep this color more neutral because it covers the largest area.)
- 2. Select the colors in tints or shades to be used in the next largest areas.
- 3. Select one or two colors that can be used as accents and accessory colors.
