**Depending on the "Type" of EDNET designation for your site, access to the EDNET Schedule will be performed as follows:*

Launch browser (i.e. Netscape, Internet Explorer) 2. Go to: www.uen.org 3. On lower right side of UEN home page, click on: <i>EDNET/ UENSS / IP Info</i> 4. Under <u>EDNET/UENSS/IP Based Videoconferencing</u> header, click on: <i>Search for EDNET Event</i> 5. Enter desired date set or Event ID#. Under Event Sites, click on the mnemonic for site you want to search. 6. Scroll down on page and click "Submit". 7. Schedule will appear for the searchable date(s), site, and classes. 	<p><u>TIPs and/or Problems:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ CMe Schedule is the way all Legacy sites have accessed their schedules in the past. ➤ Unfortunately, with the new iView scheduling program, only Legacy sites and Gateways are viewable in the CMe format. ➤ Make sure to enter "2005" – not "05" for year date set. CMe only understands full year designation. ➤ Check schedule often, at beginning of each semester AND weekly to confirm correct schedule outline. ➤ <u>For Class Schedule problems. <p>Hybrid Events (Those events that include Legacy EDNET sites, Satellite sites, and IVC sites)</p>	<p><i>Same as for CMe Schedule listed above.</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Due to the way iView and CMe work (or don't work) you will have listings for Legacy EDNET sites and Gateways (GWs), BUT NOT specific satellite or IVC site listings.

<p>Satellite Sites</p>	<p>Same as for CMe Schedule listed above.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ <u>BUT</u>, individual Satellite site designations will not appear on CMe site list ➤ <u>Only classes that include "Hybrid Events"</u> will show up on CMe schedule 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ <u>If you are a Satellite site</u>, it is recommended that you get your schedule from each sponsoring Institution that is originating your classes.

<p>IVC (IP, Tandberg, Polycom) Sites</p>	<p><u>2-Week iView Class Listings:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ <i>iView is the scheduling program for IVC sites</i> ➤ Go to: www.uen.org ➤ Click on <u>A-Z Site Index</u> link directly under the Search Box in the upper left side of home page. ➤ Under A-Z Site Index header, click on <u>Distance Learning Catalog</u> ➤ On the lower portion of the listings, there are <u>4 downloadable options</u> for iView schedules: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ 2 options (1 in Excel & 1 in PDF formats) are <u>listed by sponsor</u>. ✓ 2 options (1 in Excel & 1 in PDF formats) are <u>listed by site</u>. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ iView only lists classes for a 2-week period. ➤ UEN is working diligently trying to get the new iView software to accept Legacy site, satellite site, and IVC site listings. During the transition period, it could take a year or so before all the bugs are worked out. ➤ <u>Originating Institution classes</u> appear here. ➤ <u>Receive site classes</u> appear here.
