






Using Duo Video

Origination of Duo Video Using the Crestron Controller

Note: The Duo Video is only available when connected to another site in an active call.

<p>1. Locate the "Duo" bus on the Control Panel</p>		<p>3. To start the stream, press the "Present" button</p> <p>Note: The button indicates the current status of the duo video: When the button reads "Present *OFF*" the duo stream is not being sent. When the button reads "Present *ON*" the duo stream is active.</p>	
<p>2. Select the video source you would like to show on the second stream.</p> <p>There are 4 sources available on this bus:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Camera 1 Camera 2 Elmo/PC DVD/VHS player <p>Note: This is a high-resolution signal sent in VGA. It may not be suitable for motion video such as DVD's.</p>		<p>When the stream is active, the monitor views should change automatically to show the duo stream in the large window and the near and far sites in smaller windows.</p>	<p>Duo Stream Far Site Near Site</p> 
<p>3. If Elmo/PC is chosen, select the input, Elmo or PC, from the Elmo Control panel.</p>		<p>4. To end the duo video stream, press the "Present" button again.</p>
