

Anne Frank: Newspaper

Summary

Students research information about the Holocaust.

Intended Learning Outcomes

To learn about the basic history surrounding the Holocaust. To improve research skills.

Instructional Procedures

See preface material from 'Anne Frank in the World, 1929 - 1945 Teacher Workbook.'

Have students use their library skills to research information about the Holocaust or a current example of prejudice. They can use books, encyclopedias, magazines and newspapers from the appropriate time period. Each student should choose a specific aspect of the Holocaust and write articles, editorials (include questions for thought), and letters to the editor. The class can then come together and create a 'newspaper' or news magazine that can then be used for future classes as a learning tool.
