

FACS: Dishtowel Apron (Textiles)

Summary

After learning the simple basics of threading a sewing machine, the students will complete an apron using the serger, sewing machine, backstitch, and measuring.

The more you order, the less expensive the towels are. This pattern uses 1 towel for the apron and 1 towel cut into 3 parts for the pocket. You will order 3/1 for each type of apron. The 1-inch check in burgundy, navy, and dark green works well.
