

Adaptation of Birds from Project Wild

Summary

Students will use clues from bird beaks and feet to design a bird. They will then write about the environment of that bird and how its structures enable it to survive.

Time Frame

1 class periods of 60 minutes each

Student Prior Knowledge

Students should be familiar with the concept that certain traits help organisms survive better in certain environments.

Instructional Procedures

- Read the introduction and procedures with students.
- Allow students time to create their birds and write the paragraph.
- Have students share their work in a group of 4 and pick one to present to the class.
