Internet Key for Tree Leaves

Summary

Students will use an Internet key to identify tree leaves.

Time Frame

1 class periods of 60 minutes each

Group Size

Individual

Materials

computer with Internet access real tree branches (just the ends) or <u>pictures (see attached)</u>

- student worksheet

Instructional Procedures

Reserve the computer lab or laptops. If they are not available, a single classroom computer with a projector could be used to demonstrate the use of the key.

You might collect tree branch (several leaves on a short branch) and preserve them with book time on cardstock or ask student to bring in samples from their yards.

Read the student page with students and make sure they are all on this website.

Ask student to identify the leaves provided, using the Internet tree key.

Students should fill out the data in the student sheet as they identify their trees.

If time allows, tour your school yard and look for additional trees to key. Students may also be assigned to look at trees in their yards or neighborhoods.
