# **Bioethical Decision Making**

### Summary

Students will read a scenario based six different genetics bioethical situations. They will then use a decision making model to make bioethical choices if faced with this scenario.

### Time Frame

1 class periods of 60 minutes each

### **Background for Teachers**

#### A note to the teacher:

Whenever discussing genetic conditions be sure to be sensitive to students or students' loved ones, who may suffer from a genetic condition.

# Instructional Procedures

Make a copy of student sheets and vignettes. Give each student group a different vignette.

Allow students to read their vignettes and discuss with their groups.

Let students complete the decision making model

Allow a student or two from each group who are willing, to share their decisions and justify why they made them.
