How Do I Get Started?

Signup & Login

Signup and Login to the website.

Create a channel

Visit your **My Account** page and create a new channel. Make note of your channel number and password.

Once you have created a channel you may choose to upgrade it to a Pro or Premium channel to take advantage of the features they offer.

Record an episode

Once you've created a channel and password, call the U.S. number and be ready to record your podcast.

Tag

Tag your episode to make it easier to recognize and to make it searchable!

Publish

Publish your recording, either via the phone, or via your **My Account** page

Creating a Channel (podcast) and post it to your blog

Add New Channel

Channel Details

Title

A short title to describe this channel

Give your podcast channel a name and a description. I used my blog's name and description.

Description

Describe what your channel is about

Be sure to create a numeric password for your podcast.

Channel Password

The password used to access your channel over the phone. Must be numeric.

Channel Conference Password

If you want to enable the **Conference Calling (?)** feature, set a numeric password here. Attendees to your conference will enter this password, along with your channel number, to join your conference. This cannot be the same as the channel password above.

Category

Each channel is sorted into a Category, so select a category relevant to what your channel is about

Keywords

(separate keywords with a space)

Keywords are used to allow your channel to be more easily searched. Enter any relevant keywords that relates to your channel


Channel Website

Optional. Enter the website address for your channel.

Some blog sites, like LiveJournal, do not let you embed objects, and trying can mess up the formatting of your blog. Turn this off if that happens to you. In that case, you will only see a direct link to your audio in your blog.

Add

Use Blogger 2 as the host for your blog and then enter the information (name and password) for your blog.

By selecting yes, gabcast will automatically create a post and embed the podcast in the post.
