Managing media on your miniature mobile devices

eMedia is a library of Resources collected from a variety of providers. UEN manages the database and helps with access. Most of the collection is accessible on iOS and Android devices and the downloadable videos can be added to most mobile devices. Here's how!

1. Visit <http://www.uen.org/emedia> or Login at <http://my.uen.org> and click on the eMedia link
2. Use the Search tools to find a video you want to have on your device. Click the download link. The video will download to your computer. Make sure you take note of where it is going.
3. On a Mac or Windows computers with iOS devices, you can add the video to iTunes by importing it or dragging and dropping it into the library.
 - a. Connect your device
 - b. Select the videos you want synced to your device
 - c. sync the device
 - d. You can now use the videos on your device.
4. On Windows machines with most Android devices you can simply plug it in and the computer will recognize your device as an external memory drive and allow you to drag and drop video files into a folder on the device. Your media player on the device should recognize it and play it.
5. Remember that on most devices you can browse to eMedia and stream the video directly by clicking the Download button.
