Student has a clear main idea, but is very brief in previewing what the rest of the essay will look like.

I think the United States should stop making pennies because it is cheaper to buy toys for \$9.95 than it is for \$9.99. A good reason for getting rid of the penny is every time you would make a penny you would save 2 cents because it costs to cents to make a 1 cent coin. If the government got rid of pennies it would be ok because the nickels cost 10¢ to make and the dimes cost 5¢ to make.

Although the student uses evidence to begin their opinion, they did not think through the cost scenario between penny and nickel.

I think the United States should get rid of the pennies because most people in our time use debit or credit cards and not as much cash and coins. I also think the United States should get rid of pennies because its currency is less than its production cost. Most charities don't care if the penny will stop being made and the Salvation Army says that the group which gets many coin donations are not worried.

Transitions are present, but not smoothly integrated.

To sum up I think United States should get rid of the penny because a lot of countries in the world don't have there lowest valued coins anymore and because if the United States takes away the penny they can save a total of a lot of money. In conclusion the U.S. should get rid of the penny because the nickel and the dime produce the same money as they do to make them because a nickel plus a dime equals fifteen cents and the total to make one dime and one nickel together is fifteen cents.

This student shows the ability to keep the paper somewhat focused, but does not adequately use the information from the text to establish the opinion and synthesize the information coherently. Mechanics and conventions are adequate.

A lot of information is used here for the argument, but tangents take away both the focus and elaboration of the evidence. Circular reasoning with several different facts does not adequately show analysis skills.

is less expensive than zinc. A penny is 97.5% zinc and only 2.5% coper. So if we make pennies out of steel it would save us a lot of money and we wouldn't have to use the nickel. Experts have said that since the penny an the nickel cost lots to make, that we should just get rid of both of them and stick with the dime. But then again the dime does cost 5 cents to make. More than it would a penny. Pennies cost 2 cents to make nickels cost 10 cents to make and dimes cost 5 cents to make. Pennies cost less then it would to make a nickel or a dime. So why get rid of it if it costs less to make?

In conclusion, I think that we should still use pennies. It will save us money. Some of you might disagree or some of you might agree.

Conclusion is not parallel with introduction and does not adequately convey the main idea.

This student shows adequate command of conventions and mechanics, but lacks in elaboration of evidence, as well as struggles with remaining focused on a main idea. They did not clarify the main idea as stated, nor did they conclude the main idea. They did, however, use evidence, albeit in a choppy fashion.

Conclusion wraps up the very brief argument created by the student, but fuses no new material or concluding points to enhance the argument.

The mechanics and conventions were not adequate enough so as to not distract the reader from the main idea and flow of the essay, even though there are some grammatical errors. The focus is limited throughout and the evidence is lacking analysis and elaboration.
