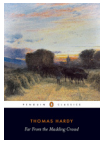


## If you like *Independent Characters*.....

### *Far From the Madding Crowd* by Thomas Hardy

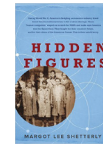
In Victorian England, a spirited woman manages her own estate and three very different suitors.
