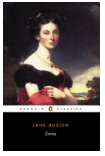

### **Winter's Tale by Mark Helprin**

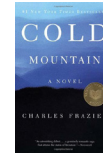
An Irish burglar falls in love with a dying girl from New York and ignites a miracle.
