Hone the Goal

- · Will the interaction directly align with a core standard?
- What is the intended impact on learning, and how will you assess the impact?



Understand Limitations

- Will the interaction depend on artificial intelligence's ability to provide factual information or in-depth expertise?
- Can the artificial intelligence tool consistently mediate the interaction in a meaningful way?



Mitigate Risks

- Has the artificial intelligence tool been vetted and approved by your LEA?
- How will you prevent over-reliance on Al while promoting students' creativity and critical thinking skills?



Assess the Interaction

- Will students reflect on the interaction?
- Will students critique the artificial intelligence's responses or compare them to human-generated ideas?



Nurture Human Connection

- Will the interaction replace, shorten, extend, or deepen a human interaction?
- Will the interaction support students' individuality while promoting a sense of classroom community?

- Summarizing texts
