Project Description	This project is designed for Utah’s 6 th grade curriculum. Students will identify their favorite place in their community, take a picture of it, identify its Lat/Long coordinates, write a report on this place and its people, then podcast their report to the world if allowed.
Community Issue or Problem Selected -How project evolved?	Students will help improve their sense of community, develop networks with leaders who preside over their “favorite” places, improve their research, writing, verbal skills, and practice fluency through their rehearsals of podcasts. I wanted to do something positive to start out and have the students motivated about maps, geography and GIS.
Community Partner(s)	This will vary with the individual students of my class. I will choose to do an interview with the football coach at Westlake High School in our school boundaries.
