Sample Questions for Gathering Oral Histories:

- 1. What is your full name?
- 2. Why did your parents select this name for you? Did you have a nickname?
- 3. When and where were you born?
- 4. How did your family come to live in this community (or Utah)?
- 5. What do you remember about your home growing up? (e.g. farm, ranch, acreage, number of rooms, electricity, phones)
- 6. What was your favorite thing to do for fun? (e.g. movies, trips, etc.)
- 7. Did you have family chores? What were they? Which was your favorite or least favorite?
- 8. Did you get an allowance for your chores? If yes, how much?
- 9. What was school like for you as a child?
- 10. Where did you attend elementary, middle, high school? What subjects did you like?
- 11. What school activities did you participate in? (Band/orchestra; dance, sports, school government) When and where did you perform?
- 12. What city, state, or world events had the most impact on you while you were growing up? Did any of them personally affect your family?
- 13. How were holidays celebrated in your home? What were your special traditions? What did you family enjoy doing together?
- 14. What stories do you remember your parents or grandparents telling you?
- 15. Did you go to college? What did you study and why?
- 16.Did you have any pets? What were they and what were their names? Where did you keep them?
- 17. What were your jobs and how did you choose them?
- 18. What places of interest do you wish you could visit and why?
- 19. What do you want people to remember about you? about the city? about the state?
- 20.Is there anything you would like to add?
