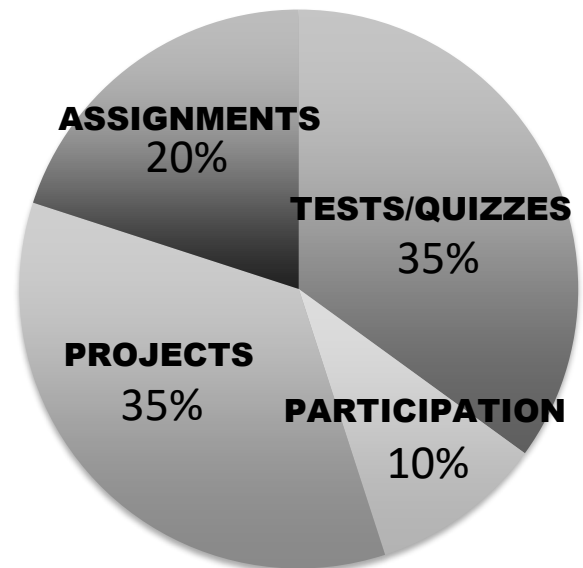

Late Work/Makeup Policy: All work is due one week before the end of each term. I will not accept any work after that. All projects will be completed in class. No sewing will be done outside of class.

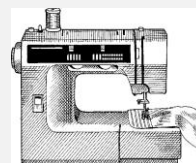
If Absent: Go to my website and look at the class calendar to see what you missed. All PowerPoints and assignments are available on my website.

SEWING SUPPLIES

(Label supplies with your name and have them by February 6)

- **Sewing pins:** in a closed container or in a pin cushion (required- worth points)
- **Seam ripper:** (required-worth points)
- **Hand needles:** at least two (required- worth points)
- **Black or white spool of thread for classroom use:** (required- worth points)
- **Fabric marking pen/pencil** (required- worth points)
- **Seam gauge** (required- worth points)
- **Clothing shears** (optional- we do have some in the lab)
- **Container to hold your supplies** (not required, but highly recommended)
- **Fabric and matching thread for projects:**
 - **Sample Book:** 1 yard of 100% cotton fabric that has a noticeable front and back.
Have by February 6.
 - **Pillowcase:** $\frac{7}{8}$ yard of 100% cotton fabric for body and $\frac{3}{8}$ yard of another 100% cotton fabric for band (flannel works great).
Have by February 27.
 - **Pajama Pants:** Amount will depend on size (about 3 yards of flannel).
Have by March 14.
 - **Pieced Pillow:** $\frac{3}{4}$ yard of 100% cotton fabric, $\frac{1}{4}$ yard coordinating cotton fabric, and $\frac{1}{4}$ yard another coordinating cotton fabric. Bag of Poly-fil stuffing.
Have by March 29.
 - **Stuffed Animal:** Amount of fabric and date due will be announced later in semester.
