A REGISTERED DIETITIAN (RD) is an expert in food and nutrition and an advocate for healthy eating. Registered dietitians are employed in a variety of settings, such as health care facilities and child nutrition programs. USU offers two programs in Dietetics the Coordinated Program in Dietetics (which includes an internship during junior and senior year) & the Didactic Program in Dietetics (which includes an internship following graduation). Both are accredited by the Commission on Accreditation for Education in Nutrition and Dietetics. Admission into either program requires a formal application process during spring semester of the sophomore year.
