

# FCC<sup>2</sup>LA BINGO

To introduce new students to some of the features of FCCLA, I use the following game during the first week of school. This BINGO styled game introduces terms without trying to explain or define any of them.

I like to use this game on the first day of school after students have filled out MANY forms and endured my spiel about class rules and expectations. I find that playing a game accomplishes two important goals:

- Establish the casual, interactive atmosphere I want in my classroom
- Present information about FCCLA

Each column of the game board has terms related to a specific part of FCCLA.

Column 1 – National Programs

Column 2 – STAR Events

Column 3 – History and Traditions

Column 4 – State and National Meetings

Column 5 – Mississippi Proficiency Events


To make the game on the computer, I prepared the master card by creating a table and typing the information into it. Then, I made the students cards by creating a smaller table (I used 5 columns and 8 rows) and pasting individual terms from the master card to the appropriate spaces on the student cards. I only included one student card in this packet. Each student card is different from the other cards.

I use dried lima beans as markers. I also keep a “Treasure Chest” of small items such as stickers, pencil toppers, hard candies, etc. to give as prizes to the winners. Students like this game and we play it more than once per class.
