CHARACTERISTICS OF MOTOR DEVELOPMENT

- 1. Eyes are closed most of the time.
- 2. The mouth is active--yawns, sneezes, quivers, hiccups.
- 3. The entire body moves.
- 4. Breathing is irregular.
- 5. Lifts head briefly when lying on stomach.
- 6. Curls up in prenatal fashion.
- 7. Responds to loud noises.
- 8. Flinches at light.
- Moro, Darwinian (grasping), and Babinski reflexes present at birth but disappear.
- 10. The head wobbles and jerks about if unsupported.

11. The more discomfort a baby feels, the more movements he/she makes.
