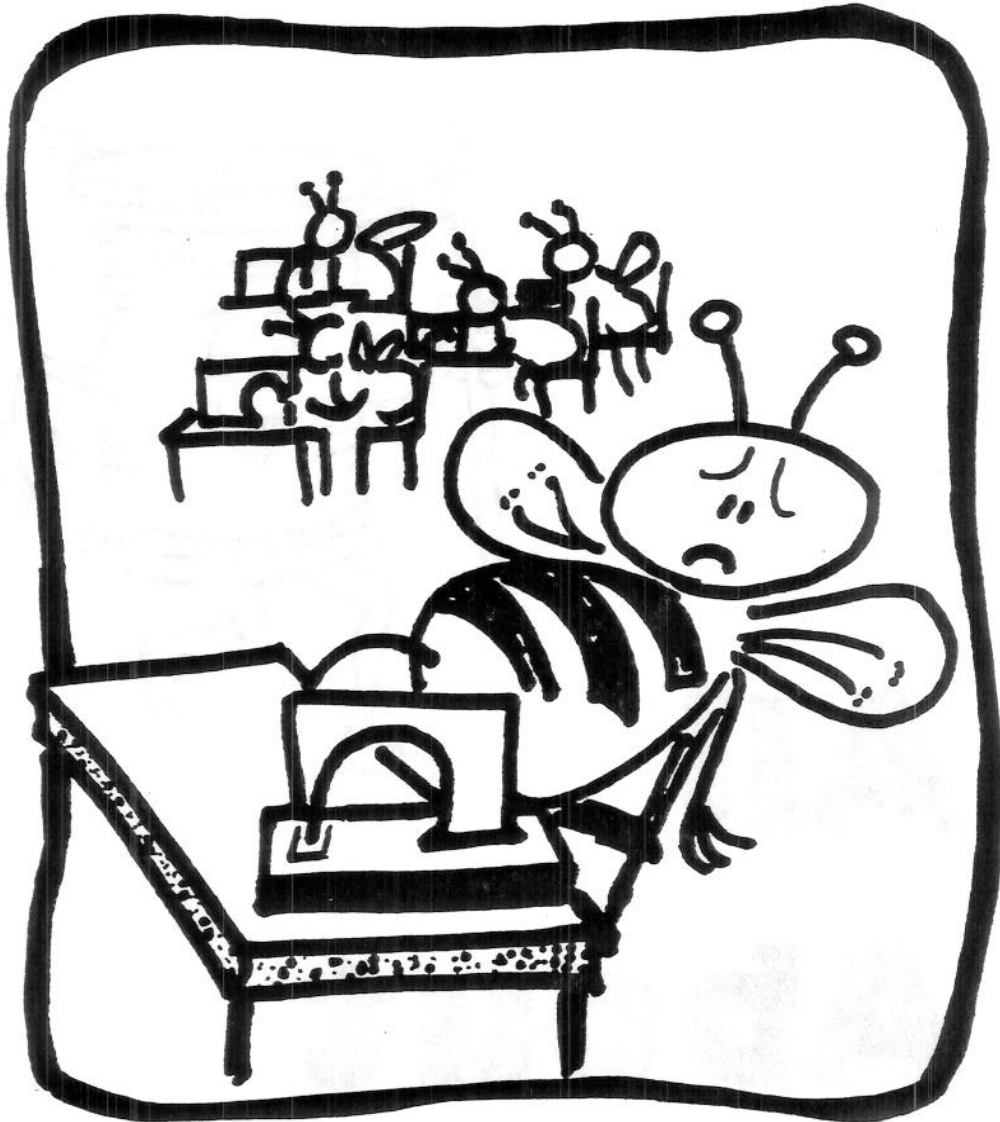
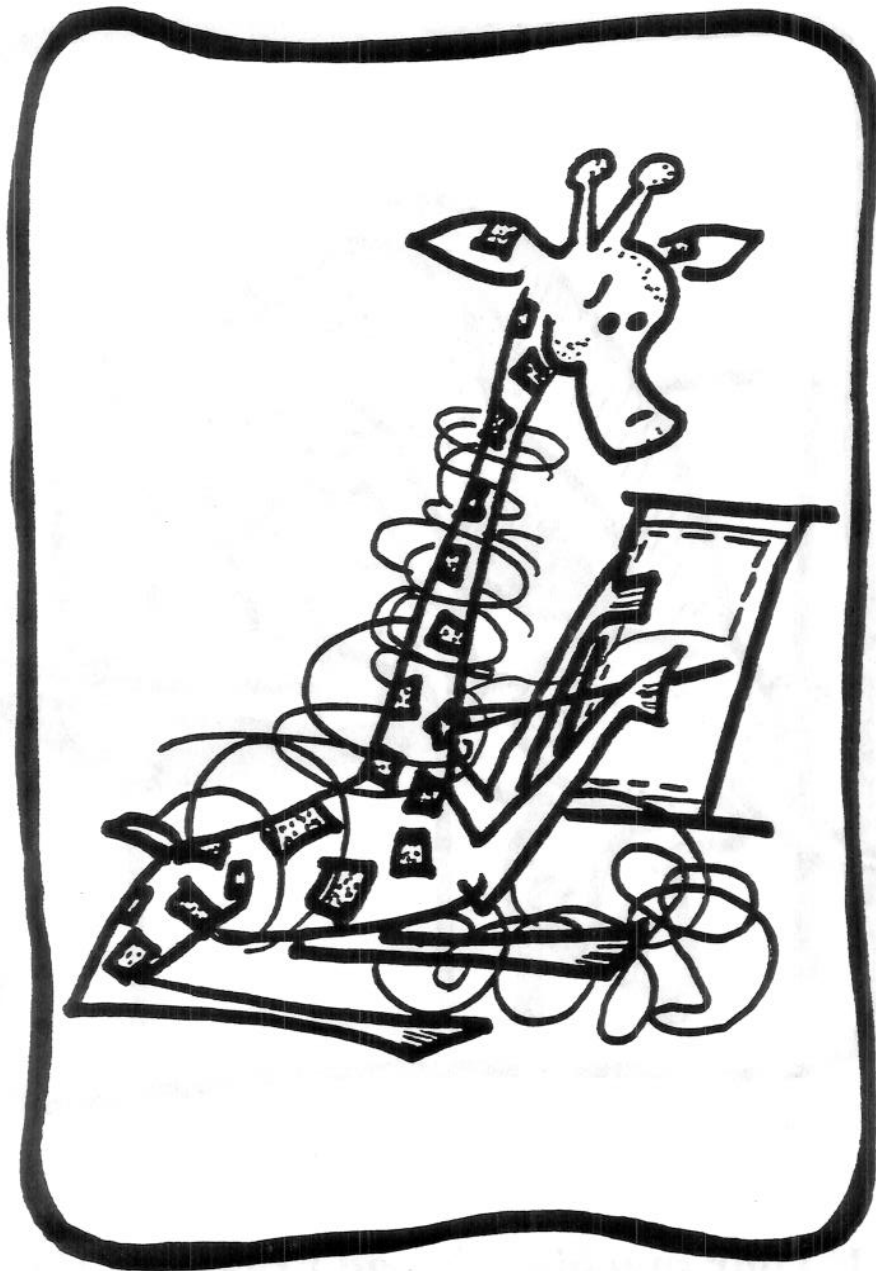

**To prevent tangling,
use only 18 to 24 inches of thread
when sewing by hand.**

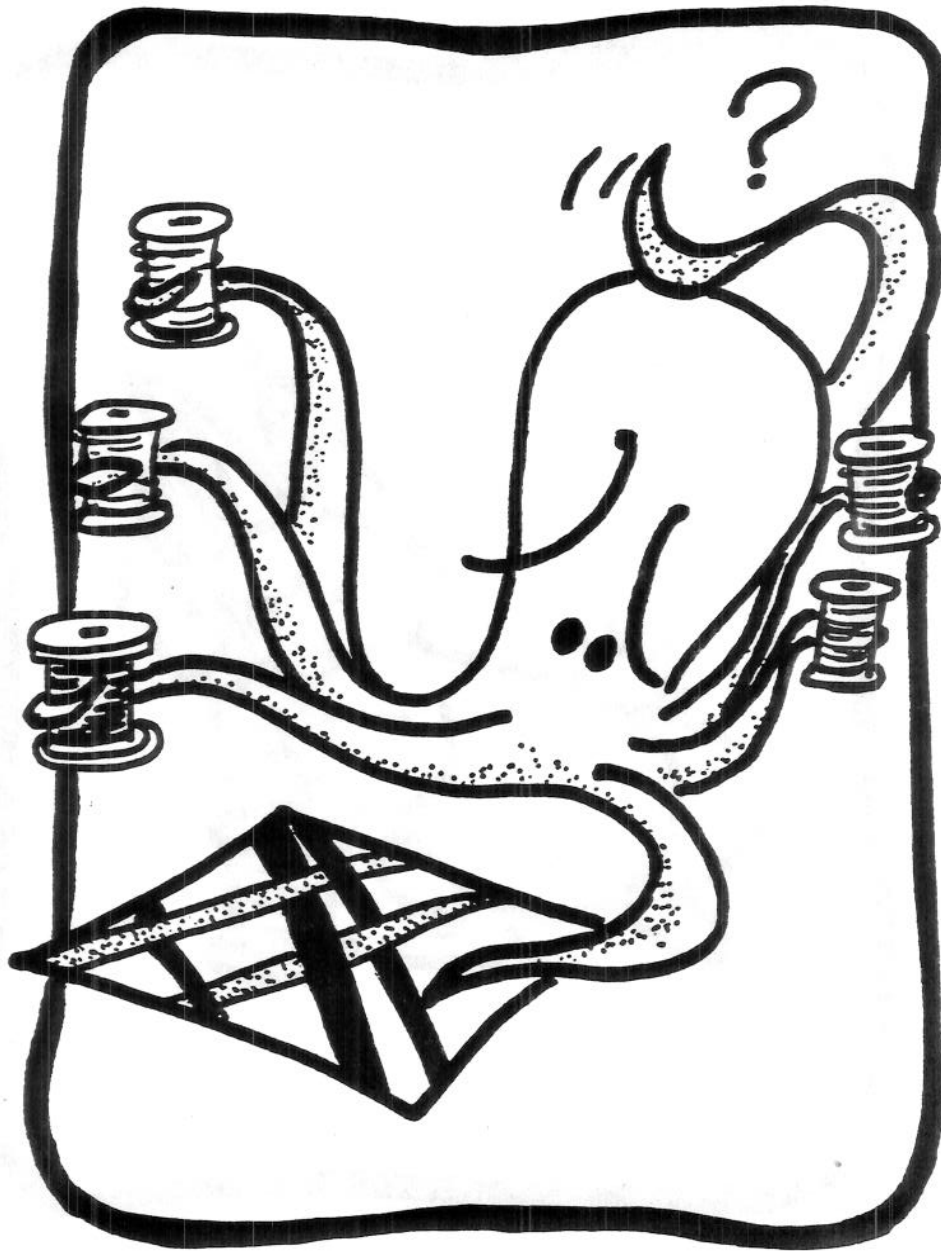


If your machine thread breaks or the needle comes unthreaded, is your:

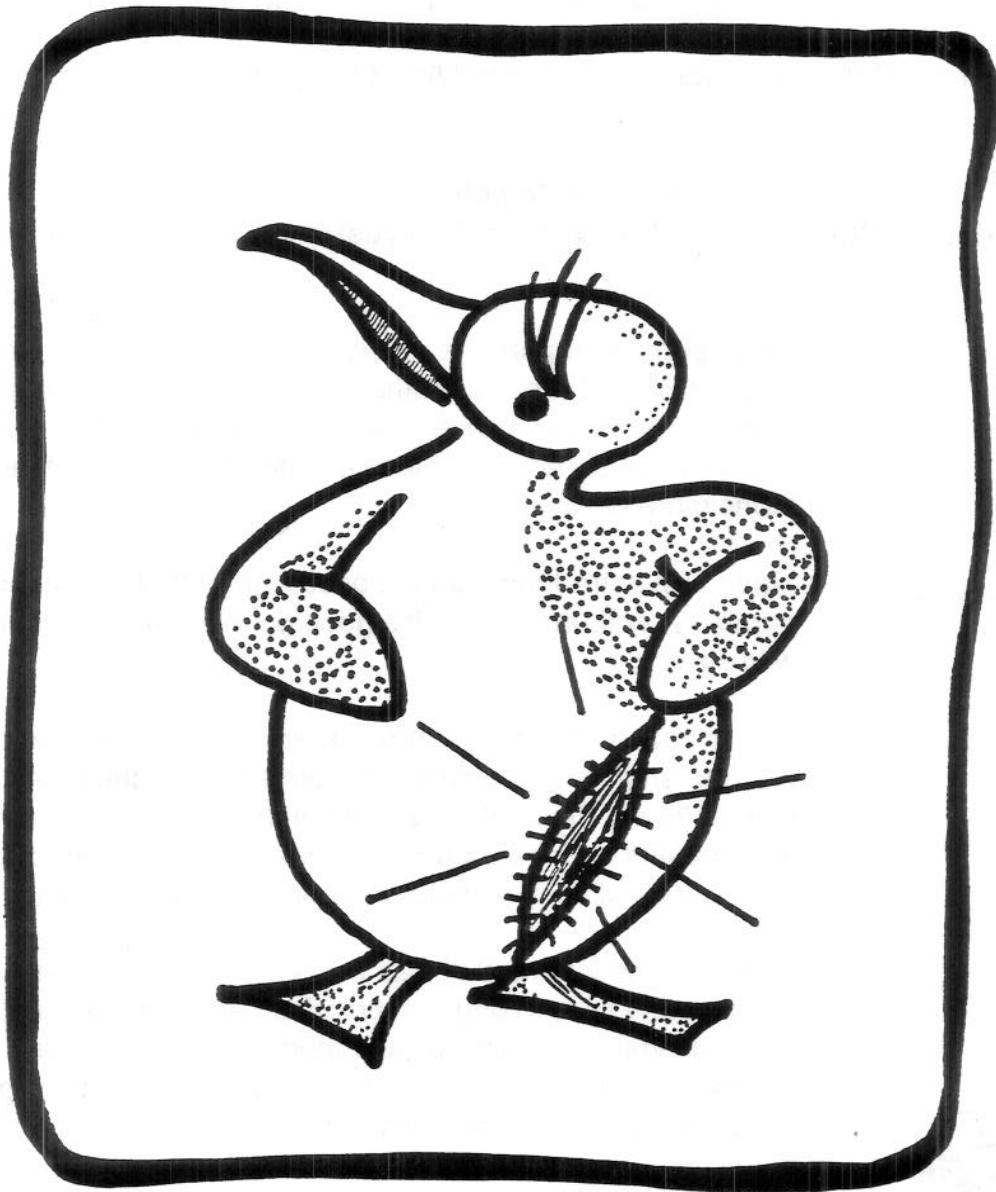
- **Machine threaded correctly?**
- **Needle inserted properly?**
- **Bobbin inserted correctly?**
- **Take-up lever in the correct position?**



**Cut thread diagonally
for easy threading.**



**Match the dominant color
in the plaid, stripe, or print.
Choose a darker rather than lighter shade.**



**Buy cotton/polyester thread
for knit fabrics
to prevent popped or puckered seams.**
