CHILD CARE TEACHING GROUPS

There are many, many ways to set up a teaching rotation schedule. Three of the most common schedules are explained below. However, you may need to make slight or major changes to accommodate your classroom needs. A sample of a weekly rotation is included with this lesson.

WEEKLY ROTATION:

ENTIRE CLASS has two weeks to plan for upcoming teaching experience.

GROUP 1 Observes a community child care center.

GROUP 2 Teaches in the school child care center.

GROUP 3 Observes a child care facility that works with children with disabilities.

GROUP 4 Observes in an elementary school.

THREE WEEK ROTATION:

GROUP A Observes and works in an elementary school.

GROUP B Teaches in the school child care center.

GROUP C Plans for teaching and completes classwork.

CLASS SPLIT

GROUP A Observes and works in community child care centers and school child care lab.

GROUP B Completes classwork.
