RULES FOR COMMUNITY EXPERIENCE

- 1. You are to keep, in detail, a daily journal or diary of the activities you observe and help with while at the school. Include the following for each day:
 - a. What was the activity or activities:
 - b. How did you help?
 - c. How did the children respond?
 - d. What learning seemed to be taking place?
 - e. List the activities which you actually led.
 - f. Write a summary including your feelings about the experience and the activities carried out in your assigned area.
- 2. Volunteer to lead at least one activity for the children and willingly fulfill assignments made by the teacher. (If the teacher does not make an assignment by the second day, ask him/her about it.)

3.	The journal is to be turned in at the end of your two week experience.

- 4. You are to be at your assigned school no later than 10 minutes after the class period begins and to stay no later than 10 minutes before it ends. YOU SHOULD SPEND 60 MINUTES PER DAY AT YOUR SCHOOL. DO NOT COME TO ROLL CALL on days you are assigned to a community school. Meet the people you ride with and leave immediately.
- 5. If you do not attend your assigned school each day (or let the teacher know you will not be there) YOU WILL RECEIVE AN "F" FOR THIS EXPERIENCE.
- 6. If you are ill, it is your responsibility to call the teacher you are working with. The telephone number of the school you will be placed is
- 7. If there is an assembly being held during the time you should be in the school. Let your teacher know in advance what time you will be to his/her school.
- 8. DO NOT take gum, food, or candy into your classroom.
- 9. You are responsible for your own transportation.
- 10. I will visit or call schools at some time while you are there.
- 11. You will be evaluated by the teacher with whom you are working.
- 12. Clothing must be modest and clean and should follow the dress codes established by the center you are visiting.
