ACTIVITIES:

- 1. Invite employees from a fabric shop into class to show the latest in fabrics and notions.
- 2. Check with fabric shops for class room demonstrations using sergers, or other special machines.
- 3. Invite someone in your area who works at home producing home sewn items for sale at boutiques or in retail stores, to talk about their work.
- 4. Set aside a few minutes once a week for a "show and tell" day. You or your students can tell about textile projects they or someone they know are involved in.
- 5. Make items along with your students to set an example and show them your enthusiasm for sewing.
