

FABRICS CROSSWORD

ACROSS CLUES:

- 1. Fibers that come from plants or animals
- 6. Finished goods in a salable state
- 8. Variation of the twill weave in which the wale changes direction at regular intervals to produce a zigzag effect
- 9. Place where fabric is woven
- 10. Narrow edge of woven fabric, usually of stronger yarns or denser construction than the body of the fabric
- 11. Threads running through the length of a piece of fabric
- 13. Tightly woven jacquard fabric with a warp effect in the figure which is raised to give a puffed appearance
- 14. Weave in which each warp thread is passed over two or more filling threads, with the interlacing advancing one thread on successive warps--has wales or diagonal lines
- 15. Method of dyeing in which a pattern is covered with wax, the fabric is then dyed, producing a white design on a dyed background
- 16. A roller is etched with the design, then the cloth passes between the roller and cast-iron cylinder to print the design
- 18. A conjunction meaning "in case that" or "whether"
- 22. Adjective meaning "immediately preceding or following"
- 24. Dye is added to loose fibers
- 25. A construction method used to produce carpet
- 28. A yarn produced by twisting two different yarns together to form a single yarn
- 32. Rubbing off of color from woven or printed fabrics
- 33. Plain, tightly-woven cotton fabric with fine yarns and processed with a glazed finish
- 36. Made from skins and hides of animals
- 37. Two or more different staple fibers are spun together into a single yarn
- 38. Threads running width-wise across a piece of fabric
- 40. A small sample of a piece of fabric
- 41. A closely-woven pile fabric produced in both a crush and cut design
- 43. A heavy jacquard fabric (usually multicolored) used only for upholstery
- 44. A plain weave cotton cloth characterized by a sheen ranging from dull to bright

DOWN CLUES:

- 2. Amount of warp and filling per square inch of fabric as it comes from the loom
- 3. The make-up of the yarn content of any given fabric
- 4. Design is applied to a screen, then color is forced through the screen to print the design
- 5. Fabric that has been pressed with engraved rollers to give a "water marked" effect
- 6. Formation of fiber fuzz balls on fabric surface by wear or friction
- 7. A jacquard woven fabric with floral or geometric patterns created with different weave effects
- 12. Weave consisting of one thread over and one thread under
- 15. Weave that is a variation of the plain weave (where two or more filling yarns are passed over and under the same number of warp yarns)
- 17. A weave achieved by passing paired warp yarns over and under filling yarns in a figure-eight configuration
- 19. Wool fibers interlocked permanently by applying heat, moisture, agitation, and pressure to fibers
- 20. A piece of fabric usually less than 3 yards long
- 21. Fabric that has been processed by dyeing, printing, applying of special resins and finishes, etc.
- 23. A woven design made with the aid of a jacquard head which may vary from simple to elaborate
- 26. Weave that produces smooth, lustrous fabrics because of the long floats on the surface of the fabric
- 27. Manufactured, scientifically produced fibers used in the fabric
- 29. Multicolored jacquard woven fabric with floral or figured pattern emphasized by contrasting colors
- 30. A finish that is applied to fabrics making them oilproof and waterproof
- 31. Continuous strand of fibers
- 34. A fine, plain, nubby weave fabric, usually with a sheen on its surface
- 35. Printing process seldomly done commercially, as it is done by hand and is therefore too costly and slow
- 39. Fabric is passed through the dye solution
- 42. Short fibers that are twisted to make a yarn
