UNIT: Backgrounds and Surface Treatments LESSON: Floor Coverings

COMPETENCIES:

1. Identify hard, soft, and resilient floor coverings.

- 2. List advantages and disadvantages of each type of floor treatment, including characteristics, cost, and care.
- 3. Demonstrate a knowledge of vocabulary associated with floor coverings.
- 4. Demonstrate carpet buymanship including a brief knowledge of common fibers and their characteristics.

OVERVIEW/SUMMARY:

Floors take more wear and tear than any other area of the home. As a background element, they set the mood or desired feel of a room. Because one must live with a flooring decision for a very long time, care must be taken when selecting floor coverings.

MOTIVATOR:

Ask what kind of a floor treatment one would select for a cabin, a living room, a patio, a kitchen, a child's room, etc. Discuss why different floor treatments were chosen for different areas.
