STAR EVENTS

FHA-HERO and their Star Events are continually changing. Below are a few Star Events that would be particularly applicable to Interior Design. Assignments have been formatted to coincide with the Star Event requirements. It will be imperative to check the current Star Event manual and up-date these guidelines each time they are used.

APPLIED TECHNOLOGY EVENT

This event may be completed as an individual or a team. It recognizes participants who develop a project using technology, and show evidence of problem solving, critical thinking and integration of applied communication, math and/or science skills in a family and consumer science related area.

ENTREPRENEURSHIP EVENT

This event may be completed as an individual or a team. It recognizes participants who develop a plan for a small business using family and consumer science related skills and knowledge of sound business practices.

ILLUSTRATED TALK EVENT

This event may be completed as an individual. It recognizes participants for their ability to make a presentation about life issues concerning family and consumer sciences.

JOB INTERVIEW EVENT

This event may be completed as an individual. It recognizes participants who use family and consumer science related skills to develop a portfolio, participate in an interview, and communicate a personal understanding of job requirements.

SKILLS FOR LIFE EVENT

This event may be completed as an individual or a team. It recognizes participants who develop a "how to" presentation that explains a life skill used to plan and/or implement a project related to a national FHA-HERO program (Project 2000).

The following state events are NOT national events and do not compete beyond the current area conventions.

INTERIOR DESIGN EVENT

This event may be completed as an individual or team. It recognizes participants for their knowledge of the interior design field. An interior design presentation shows the student's knowledge of interior design by presenting an oral presentation about one aspect of interior design and how it improves the aesthetics of space in a home or office.

DEMONSTRATION EVENT

This event may be completed as an individual. It recognizes participants for their knowledge and ability to give a demonstration about issues concerning family and consumer sciences. A demonstration is showing and telling an audience how to do something. Charts and posters may be used in a demonstration. The presenter will select and organize facts and ideas and practice thinking and speaking before a group.

Star Events that could be adapted to Interior Design

CHAPTER SERVICE PROJECT EVENT:

This event may be completed as a team. It recognizes chapters that develop and implement an in-depth service project that makes a worthwhile contribution to families, schools, communities and/or family and consumer science education.

CHAPTER SHOWCASE EVENT:

This event may be completed as a team. It recognizes chapters that develop and implement a well-balanced program of work and promote FHA-HERO and family and consumer science to the community.

INTERPERSONAL COMMUNICATIONS EVENT:

This event may be completed as an individual or a team. It recognizes participants who develop an individual school or community project designed to strengthen interpersonal communications and apply communication knowledge and skills to similar situations.
