RAIN STICKS

WHAT YOU NEED:

- PAPER TOWEL ROLLS
- TAPE THAT YOU CAN PAINT ON
- GLUE
- PAINT
- UNCOOKED RICE
- TOOTHPICKS

WHAT TO DO:

POKE HOLES INTO THE PAPER TOWEL ROLLS. HAVE YOUR CHILD POKE TOOTHPICKS THROUGH THE HOLES (GLUE BOTH ENDS). NEXT TAPE ONE END OF THE ROLL CLOSED. ADD RICE AND TAPE THE OTHER END. NEXT LET YOUR CHILD PAINT THEIR STICKS ANY WAY THAT THEY WANT. FINALLY, CUT OFF ANY ENDS OF THE TOOTHPICKS STICKING OUT. NOW YOUR CHILD HAS A GREAT RAIN STICK MADE OUT OF RECYCLED PAPER TOWEL ROLLS.
