

# Cover for Life Skills Binder

Make a cover that depicts/tells all about ME\_\_\_\_\_.

- Cut out pictures that tell about you in the following eight categories:
  - Personality—describes the inner you
  - Collections/Hobbies—things you like to do or collect
  - Abilities and Talents—things you do well naturally and developed skills
  - Friends
  - Likes
  - Dislikes
  - Family
  - School
- There must be at least 5 items describing each category (3 of these items must be pictures). You may use pictures and words from magazines, newspapers, etc. Minimum total for cover = 40 descriptors. You can draw your own pictures and write your own words using block lettering or something similar.
- As pictures are cut out, write the each picture's name on the line below. On the back of the picture write the category. Put the cut-out pictures in a brown envelope.
- Group pictures according to their category and get ready to glue them on paper. Get 2 sheets of colored paper from the cupboard.
- Label/write the name of each category on the cover. I will not grade it unless it is labeled.

Grade = 10 points each (2 points for each of the 3–5 pictures and/or 2 points for each of the 2-word descriptions)
