EQUIPMENT BAG

Fabric Requirements: 2/3 yard or 3 fat quarters

Fabric Cutting Instructions:

1- 8 1/2" x 17" Outside

1-8 1/2" x 17" Lining

1-8 1/2" x 16" Back pocket

1-8 1/2" x 13" Middle pocket

1-8 1/2" x 10" Front pocket

Velcro Cutting Instructions: 1- 1" x 3 1/2"

Step 1- Fold the 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10" fabric in half, forming the 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ "x5" front pocket.

Step 2 - Center one side of Velcro ¼" from the folded edge of the front pocket. Top stitch ¼" seam from the folded edge of the pocket, sew around Velcro.

Step 3 - Fold the back and middle pocket rectangles wrong sides together. Top stitch 1/4" from fold.

Step 4 - Layer the back, middle, and front pockets . Pin. With a pencil, draw a stitching line down the pockets at 2 ½" from each edge.

Step 5 - Sew on the stitching lines.

Step 6 - Center the Velcro on the lining 1/4" from edge. Sew on Velcro.

Step 7 - Layer lining right side up and pocket unit with Velcro facing up. Place outside rectangle with the right side down. Pin to hold all layers in place.

Step 8 - Trim 1/4" off each corner.

Step 9 - With ¼" seam allowance, sew around all edges leaving a 3" opening along the top of the flap. Turn the case right side out through the opening.

Step 10 - Top stitch around the flap. This will add a decorative touch. Sew the opening closed.

Step 11 - Hand sew a button onto the front.

Step 12 - Fill out the grade sheet rubric and hand it in.
