"How to" Video Using Photostory 3

Create a "how to" video in Photostory 3 using the following criteria:

- 1) Pick something you know how to do: _____
- 2) Use a minimum of 9 pictures
- 3) Take photos of your demonstration that can be used to show someone how to do what you're teaching.
- 4) Place the photos in Photostory
 - a. Import Pictures
- 5) In the "Add a Title to Your Pictures" page, add text and photo effects as needed. You'll need to do this for each picture.
- 6) On the "Narrate your pictures and customize motion" page, record your voice narrating the show, one slide at a time. Then, customize your motion to create motion over your photos.
- 7) Select music (from a file, .wav, mp3, or wma), or create your own music using the "create music" button. Preview the video and set your music volume.
- 8) Save the video.
 - a. Go to Settings>Profile>Select the video quality you want (Profile for Computers 1 is adequate.)>OK>Next
