Example of Kindergarten School Rules

Listening Rules:

- 1. Eyes on the person talking
- 2. Get ready by the count of 1,2,3
 - a. Zip lips
 - b. Feet on the floor, sitting on pockets/pretzel sitting on pockets
 - c. Arms folded
 - d. Playing with something—put it away
- 3. Use good manners and show respect

Classroom Rules:

- 1. Follow teacher directions the first time given
- 2. Keep hands, feet, and objects to self
- 3. Quiet voice/good language
- 4. Put others up...not down
- 5. Take turns/share/walk

Reward System:

What if I do:

- 1. More choices
- 2. Student Helper
- 3. Free time
- 4. Activities/treats
- 5. Positive praise & positive notes home

What if I don't:

- 1. Less choices
- 2. Not able to be a helper
- 3. Time out—1, 2, 3, 4, or 5 min.
- 4. Loss of an activity/treat
- 5. Negative attention or ignored & negative notes home

Severe clause:

A student may need to visit with the Principal for the following behaviors: Throwing things, threatening others, swearing, hitting, kicking, biting, spitting, pinching, punching, or running from the teacher or from the classroom.
