Emergency first-aid points

Answer: use a cold pack to bring down the swelling. Watch for dizziness, bleeding from nose and ears, headache, etc.

Answer: Call poison control, with the packaging of the solution.

Answer: 98.6 degrees F.

Answer: Call for help, pick up the child around the waist, pull upward with both hands quickly but gently three times. If the child is too small, use back blows between shoulder blades. Watch breathing and check pulse.
